Recognition of Students' Attainment in CCA

Students are recognised for their holistic development in their CCA through the LEAPS 2.0 framework. Students will be recognised with levels of attainment in four domains: Participation, Achievement, Leadership and Service. The co-curricular attainment and relevant records act as testimonials and evidence of a student's holistic development in lifelong competencies and character formation. For students in the 4-year SEC (O-Level) programme, the co-curricular attainment may be converted to bonus point(s) which can be used for admission to post-secondary institutions.
